

The Bulgarians speak one of the numerous Slavonic languages; the old Bulgarian is the ancient Slave, into which were translated, in the ninth century, the canonical books of the Old and New Testaments, which are to this day in use in the Slavonic churches of the Greek denomination. The Bulgarians settled in the country which they now inhabit during the fifth, sixth, and seventh centuries of the Christian era. They were for a long time at war with the emperors of the Eastern Empire. Now conquerors, and now tributaries of this empire, they almost always maintained their independence, forming either a kingdom more or less important, or else a province enjoying a more or less extensive autonomy. The Bulgarians embraced the Christian religion in the year 864, in the reign of their King Boris. Their apostles were the two brothers of Salonica, Cyril and Methodius, who were also the inventors of the Slavonic alphabet. Under the softening influence of Christianity the Bulgarians became a gentler people than they had been under their warlike sovereigns, among whom we may more particularly notice Asparouch (640-700) and Krum (302-815). The conversion to Christianity of the Bulgarians gave occasion to a long dispute between the Church of Rome under Pope Nicolas I. (13 November, 867), and the Church of Constantinople under the Patriarch Photius (891). Each of the two churches wished to have the new converts under its own exclusive jurisdiction. The Bulgarians ultimately remained attached...
